

The School Activities Programme has several alternative activities to encourage a variety of skills and talents which are provided by outside coaches. The details of payment and timings can be found below.

Computer based Music is a new club offered by Gareth Rubery. The club is designed to allow those boys who may not be able to play an instrument to create music through a PC. Those who do play an instrument can produce and develop their own music. Covering areas such as composition and production, it allows all to get to grips with music through a familiar and accessible medium. The activity will begin on **Wednesday 18th January and run until Wednesday 21st March** from 4:30pm until 5:30pm. The cost of the activity will be **£54 for nine sessions**.

Young Magician is a club aimed at developing a comprehensive understanding of Magic. Whether your aim is to learn 5 or 6 easy to master yet incredibly effective tricks, or you want to build a repertoire and all round performance in a term, this activity will leave you with the ability to perform close up magic confidently to your audience.
